## Drop-In Programs

The Wilmot Aquatic Centre offers a variety of drop in programs. No pre-registration. Capacity limits apply. See Admissions page for pricing.



### Adult/Senior Swim (18+)

Recreational swimming in the Leisure Pool for seniors and participants over 18 years old.



### Aquafun

*Program Capacity: 12*

An action packed class involving water games, activities and watersport. Participants must be 8 to 13 yrs and able to swim 25m comfortably and put their face in the water.



### Family Swim

*Leisure Pool Capacity: 100*

Recreational swimming in the Leisure Pool. All participants must meet the [Swim Admission Policy](#). Children (under 18) must be accompanied into the water by a parent or guardian.



### Lane Swim

Lanes are set up in the Lap Pool for fast, medium, slow and leisure swimmers. Participants are asked to choose a lane based on swimming ability. Please be aware that you may be asked to switch lanes based on swimmers participating during the swim. All participants must meet the [Swim Admission Policy](#).

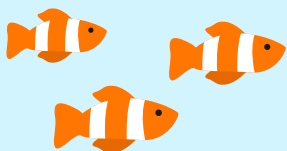


### Open Swim

*Leisure Pool Capacity: 100*

Both the Leisure Pool and Lap Pool are open for recreational swimming. 2 Lanes are set up in the Lap Pool for lengths. All participants must meet the [Swim Admission Policy](#).

### Combo Aquafit

During this one hour class, participants spend 30 minutes in the shallow end followed by 30 minutes in the deep end. Participants must wear a water belt for the duration of the class. *Please note, some instructors may begin the class in the deep end first.*



### Deep Water Aquafit

A 45-minute class of suspended movements in the deep water. Classes consist of a warmup, muscular endurance, cardio and a cool down. Participants must wear a water belt for the duration of the class.



### Easy Does It Aquafit

Capacity: 25

A 45-minute class of mild to moderate exercises performed in the Leisure Pool (warm water pool). The focus of the class is on muscle strength and stretching.

### High Intensity Aquafit

A 45-minute class consisting of high intensity cardio, strength and endurance exercises. This program will incorporate shallow and deep water components. Participants must wear a water belt in the deep water.



### Shallow Water Aquafit

A 45-minute class of stationary movements in the shallow water. Classes consist of a warmup, muscular endurance, cardio and a cool down.

## **NEW** Fall Swimming Lesson Programs

Resident Registration: Sept 5 | Non-Resident: Sept 12



### **Adapted Aquatics**

A specialized program for participants 3+ with disabilities. Adapted Aquatics is 45 mins. in length, and allows participants to work through the program with individualized instruction and modifications to suit their needs at a 1:1 or 1:2 ratio.



### **Adult and Child Aquafit**

A 45 min. class for participants and their 4 to 18 month old child. First 30 mins. will focus on strength and cardio in Lap Pool, while baby floats in a provided baby boat. The last 15 mins. spent socializing in the Leisure Pool.



### **Daytime Adult/Senior Swimming Lessons**

A 45 min. class for participants 18+ of all swim abilities. Each class consists of water safety and practical work that will help the participants reach their goal of learning to swim, stroke correction or swimming for fitness.



### **Homeschool Lessons**

Daytime lessons designed to fit into a homeschooling schedule. Sessions are offered in the afternoons for various levels from Preschool 5 to Swimmer 8.



### **Private/Semi-Private Lessons**

Private Lessons offer focused instruction to develop swimming skills. Participants will receive 1-on-1 skill building instruction.



### **Warm Pool Private Lessons**

Designed for young participants working on Swimmer 2 skills and below. 1-on-1 instruction is provided in the leisure pool.

## Online Report Cards

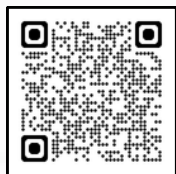
### We've made some changes!

Each participant has a custom ActiveNet ID, which will be used to login to Swim Gen. ActiveNet IDs will be sent by email before report cards are available. Keep your ActiveNet IDs in a safe place. ActiveNet IDs are unique to each participant, and will remain the same for every session on an ongoing basis.

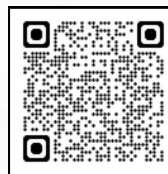

# CASTLE KILBRIDE

**Open Wednesday to Sunday 10:00am - 3:00pm**

**Admission: Adults \$9.50, Senior (65+) and Student (with ID) \$8.25, Child (4-13) \$5.25, Family (2 adults, 3 children) \$26**

Step back into the lavish Victorian era and visit the jewel of Wilmot Township. Built in 1877, Castle Kilbride is a restored and furnished mansion; home of James Livingston, Canada's "Flax Mill King." The museum features rare, nationally designated three-dimensional wall and ceiling murals known as, Trompe l'oeil, a French term that translates to "trickery of the eye." These magnificent murals reflect the Victorian love of extravagance and variety while providing an interesting illusion of depth. The museum's special exhibit for 2024 is "Fabled" pairing the childhood books of Laura Louise Livingston with costumes from the Stratford Festival Archives.

The Canada Safety Council Babysitters course is designed to teach youth how to be successful babysitters. They will learn about child development, basic first aid, and handling solutions.

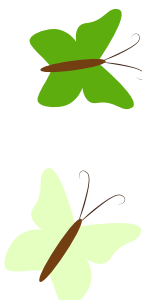

### Youth Action Council

Wilmot's Youth Action Council is open to all youth ages 14-19 within the community. Meetings run on Mondays from 7:00pm-8:30pm bi-weekly, starting September 23, 2024. Members will learn leadership skills, develop and run events within the community, and develop opportunities for youth in Wilmot.



### Youth Volunteer Leadership Program

Volunteers play an important role in ensuring the success of our various youth programs. Volunteers support program staff by playing games, helping with crafts, and instructing activities. Volunteers are ages 13-19 and must apply.



### Youth Programming Pass

A youth programming pass is required for children and youth attending registered and drop in programs where parents/caregivers are not required to stay. The program pass expires annually on June 30. Only one pass application is required per child annually.

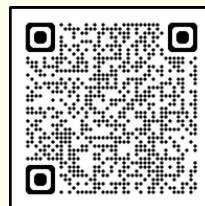

## Wilmot Outdoor Amenities

Nestled in the Township of Wilmot are a variety of outdoor spaces and amenities available to rent. Picnic shelters are generally bookable from May until October (Thanksgiving), weather permitting.

### Picnic Shelters



Wilmot Township has many scenic parks for public enjoyment. All grass, open field areas and playground equipment are considered public and are not included as part of rentable facilities. However, many of our parks have picnic shelters which can be reserved.

Picnic Shelters are available for rent at: William Scott Park, St. Agatha Park, New Dundee Park, Norm Hill Park, Petersburg Park, and Sir Adam Beck Park.

Other spaces available for rent include: Kirkpatrick Park Gazebo, New Dundee Bandshell, Heritage Park and the Arboretum.

### Sportsfields



There are a number of sports fields available for use in Wilmot Township. Whether you are looking for a baseball diamond or a soccer field, Wilmot has many to choose from. Sports fields are located on both school property and in community parks. They are available for use on a seasonal basis, typically from from May 1 to September 30, each year.

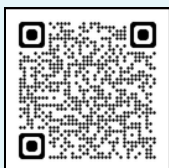
